



# SAFETY POLICIES DURING HOME VISITS

What to expect prior to and during home visits to keep your family and our providers safe.

## TELE-INTERVENTION:

ITSWC can provide early intervention via tele-intervention to support your family virtually.



## RISK ASSESSMENT:

Providers and families will answer risk assessment questions prior to your in-person home visit.



## MASK:

Masks will not be mandated, but will be highly encouraged during home visits and meetings, for those individuals who have not been fully vaccinated. Masks are optional during home visits and meetings for fully vaccinated individuals. Please discuss your family's preferences regarding wearing masks during home visits with your ITSWC provider.



## WASH HANDS:

Your provider will wash her hands when she arrives at your home. Please have soap and paper towels/napkins available for them to use.



## SANITIZE:

Prior to your visit, please sanitize toys and other items that may be used during the session by washing with soap and water or wiping with a disinfectant cloth. Your provider has disinfecting wipes that can be used to clean items used after your visit.



## NO OUTSIDE ITEMS:

In alignment with Kansas's early intervention model and for maximum safety, your provider should not bring items such as toys, food, or sensory materials to your family.



## SOCIAL DISTANCE:

Your provider will maintain 6 feet distance between adults in the room, unless deemed clinically necessary for your child's services.



## LIMIT PARTICIPANTS:

The number of people participating in your session should be limited to the child, one family member or caregiver and your provider whenever possible.
